



## Triana House

SEVILLE, SPAIN

Small may be beautiful, but in the hands of designer Amaro Sánchez de Moya, small is exquisite. The irrefutable example is his top-to-bottom vision for this new seven-room hotel named for its historic neighborhood. "I have a deep connection to Seville," the local-born Sánchez de Moya says. "I always drew inspiration from the beauty, architecture, and history of the city." In Triana House he delivers an Andalusian rhapsody inspired by the colors and textures of his homeland: bold paint palettes, bravura textiles and wallpapers, and dreamlike furniture (which he largely designed). "It's an environment that reflects a traveler's dream," Sánchez de Moya says. "Our hotel could be in a David Roberts painting, a Washington Irving short story, or a scenario for *Carmen*."
